**Prosecutor, City of Detroit and Comcast Cablevision Team up to
"Save Our Seniors"**

Wayne County Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy is pleased to announce the "Save Our Seniors" program. Worthy said, "Seniors are important and valued members of our community. We owe it to them to make sure they are safe and secure." Prosecutor Worthy, Jackie L. Currie, Clerk for the City of Detroit and Comcast Cablevision will work cooperatively on the project.

Comcast Cablevision will provide 10 adult assisted living facilities in the City of Detroit with closed circuit television equipment to monitor security at each location. The staff and residents will be trained by Comcast to use the monitors. They will be installed by April 23, 2004. Once an initial pilot program has been completed, monitors will be installed in other locations across Wayne County.

The program was conceived by Prosecutor Worthy in January 2004, for the purpose of protecting the senior population living in adult assisted living facilities. Worthy also created the first Elder Abuse Unit in the history of the Wayne County Prosecutors Office. The unit is headed by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney David McClorey to prosecute cases involving the elderly and vulnerable adult victims.
