## **New Comcast Show Highlights Unsolved Homicides**

Comcast in cooperation with Wayne County Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy, Detroit Police Chief Ella Bully-Cummings and Craig Yaldoo, President and CEO of the Alliance for a Safer Greater Detroit announce the airing of the first episode of "Speak Up Detroit." The 30-minute broadcast will be aired on Comcast Channel 6 in Detroit on Tuesday January 18, 2005 at 8:30 p.m., on Thursday January 20, 2005 at 8:30 p.m. and on Saturday January 22, 2005 at 6:30 p.m.

The 30-minute show will feature four unsolved Detroit homicides. Any member of the public with information that will help solve the featured homicides is encouraged to call 1-800-SPEAK-UP. The phone call is completely anonymous and the information is taken by Crimestoppers. A cash reward is given for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator.

Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy stated: "I am grateful that Comcast has shown its commitment to the community by giving air time to the homicides that are plaguing our city and killing our youth. We must use every means we have to solve these killings. The medium of television will be a powerful tool in our arsenal. I'm sure the families of the victims are grateful to Comcast for this valuable public service."

Craig Yaldoo echoed this sentiment: "This is an important collaboration to help engage the community to speak up about the tragic murders in our neighborhoods."
