Prosecutor charges former Detroit teacher with CSC

Wayne County Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy has charged Kimberly Dedloff, 26 of Clawson with three counts of Third Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct, which carries a maximum penalty of 15 years in prison and two counts of Second Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct, which carries a maximum penalty of 15 years in prison. The defendant was a Spanish teacher at Michigan Collegiate High School in Detroit when she allegedly had sexual contact with a then 16-year-old male student. The contact took place from February through July of 2008 at an off campus location. Ms. Dedloff left her position at the school when a complaint was filed with the police.

Dedloff is expected to be arraigned at the 36th District Court, 421 Madison, Detroit at 1:00 p.m. today.
