2. Presentation by, and discussion among Commissioners with, James Heath, Carter Fisher, Victoria Inniss-Edwards and Chief Robert Dunlap.

Mr. Heath said that the regular meeting with CJC parties will occur later in the week, and the Commission will be sent an update. He also spoke about a large list of contracts that will be coming to the Commission, and the employees that are being dedicated to getting them to the Commission for its consideration. And, he spoke about proposed changes to Detroit Department of Transportation bus routes.

Mr. Fisher said that the City of Detroit public lighting substation on the CJC property has been demolished, and the space will be used for parking.

Tim Johnson, Commission Director of Administration, said that the rescheduled CJC tour will be at 3 p.m. Aug. 18.

Ms. Inniss-Edwards said that 58 percent of the spending so far has been with County-based businesses, 6 percent has been with minority-owned businesses and 2 percent has been with women-owned businesses. She also said that outreach efforts are continuing.

Chief Dunlap said he is looking forward to having one adult jail instead of three. Concerns of the Sheriff's Office are being addressed.
