C. Approval of the October 20, 2022 meeting minutes - Action not taken due to the lack of a quorum.

D. New business

1. Update from James Heath, Carter Fisher, Jay Shandor, Bill Rath and Victoria Inniss-Edwards regarding the status of the Criminal Justice Complex

James Heath said that a contract with Oneida Solutions Group for CJC moving services is with the Commission. There will be a contract dealing with video visitation and related services coming to the Commission. The County is working with the City of Detroit regarding Detroit Department of Transportation bus routes/stops and sidewalks, streetscapes and lighting in the CJC area. He also said that negotiations with Rock over environmental issues are ongoing, and the Commission is considering an amendment to the Procurement Ordinance that will help with CJC change orders.

Carter Fisher said that the Juvenile Detention Facility will have nine classrooms, two arts and crafts rooms and a library. He also addressed environmental issues with the parking lot that's just north of the CJC, adding that remediation is expected to be minimal. In addition, the completion schedule has not changed.

Victoria Inniss-Edwards said that 58 percent of the CJC spending has been with Wayne County businesses, up from 56 percent. In addition, a little more than 8 percent has been spent with minority- and women-owned businesses. About 33-35 percent of the workforce has been Wayne County residents.

Chair Kinloch said the Special Committee will not meet in December.
