E. New Business

The Committee moved items E.1-6 together.

1. Baydoun/Kinloch **Forwarding to Full Board to receive and file.**
Communication from Art Elandt, Senior Project Manager, Department of Facilities Management & Planning, forwarding an Emergency Procurement Report for a contract with Legionella Control Systems, Inc. (of Indianapolis, IN) not to exceed \$7,500 to conduct Legionella testing and assessment, and develop a water management plan to support effective risk management, if necessary, at the Criminal Justice Complex; the term was from June 16, 2025 through September 30, 2025; the cost will be charged to Account No. 63101 265090 8170010 (CJC Operations and Management). (2025-91-014)
Motion Carried.

Art Elandt and Joan Grieg provided an overview.

There was a discussion about this issue being discussed by the Special Committee on the Criminal Justice Complex. The matter started with Sheriff's Office concerns about laundry temperatures being too low and the creation of a water management plan as a result. They also discussed working with the Procurement Division to create a bid package to extend the service to all County buildings.

2. Baydoun/Kinloch

Approved. An intergovernmental agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Charter Township of Canton not to exceed \$773,500 for the Local Partnering Initiative for township roads for the Local Road Improvements Program to allow for pavement repairs for various subdivision locations; the term will commence upon Commission approval through September 30, 2029; the cost will be charged to Account No. 20101 449070 8170010 (DPS Road Administration). (2026-30-018) Motion Carried.

Alan Ko provided an overview.

There was a discussion about the first and second phases of the Local Partnering Initiative.

3. Baydoun/Kinloch

Approved. Amendment No. 3 to a three-year contract with a one-year option to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Great Lakes Engineering Group, LLC (of Lansing) not to exceed \$32,661.78, extending the term and adding to the scope of services, to continue to provide engineering services for the Inkster Road Bridge reconstruction over E.N. Hines Drive in the cities of Dearborn Heights and Westland; per the total contract amount, it will subcontract 12.48%/\$20,004.32 to Spalding DeDecker (of Rochester Hills) for topographic survey, 7.84%/\$12,574.10 to GeoTrans Consultants, LLC (of Brighton) for soil borings and geotechnical engineering and 1.54%/\$2,474.78 to Taiga Engineering, LLC (of Dansville) for hydraulics and the Michigan

Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) permitting; the term is extended through August 2, 2029; the term of the original contract and previous amendments is from June 17, 2021 through June 16, 2026; the total amount is increased from \$127,685.65 to \$160,347.43; the cost will be charged to Account No. 20101 449080 8010090 (DPS Engineering Construction). (2021-30-049M3) Motion Carried.

Alan Ko provided an overview.

The Committee moved to Item E.5.

5. Baydoun/Kinloch

Approved. Amendment No. 1 to a three-year contract with a one-year option to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Baker and Associates (of Dearborn) not to exceed \$128,635.89, exercising the option to renew, to modify the scope of work for professional engineering and inspection services for Grosse Ile Parkway over the Trenton Channel (SN 12006) bridge repairs in the City of Trenton and Grosse Ile Township; it will subcontract 6.25%/\$65,812.63 to NTH Consultants (of Northville) for geotechnical and testing, 1.90%/\$19,980.71 to Hennessey Engineers, Inc. (of Southgate) for surveying and 21.67%/\$228,198.86 to Collins Engineering (of Chicago, IL) for structural and underwater inspection; the term is from April 11, 2026 through April 10, 2027; the term of the original contract is from April 11, 2023 through April 10, 2026; the total amount is increased from \$924,201.46 to \$1,052,837.35; the cost will be charged to Account No. 20101 449080 8010090 (DPS Engineering Construction). (2023-30-003M1) Motion Carried.

Alan Ko provided an overview.

6. Baydoun/Kinloch

Approved. Amendment No. 1 to a three-year professional services contract with a one-year option to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Wade Trim Associates, Inc. (of Detroit) not to exceed \$936,110.88, exercising the option to renew, to modify the scope of

services for construction engineering services for Oakwood Boulevard, from Beech Street to Rotunda Drive, in the City of Dearborn; per the total contract amount, it will subcontract 7.12%/\$126,033.91 to Somat Engineering, Inc. (of Detroit) for materials testing and inspection support services and 1.40%/\$24,815 to SME (of Plymouth) for mast arm fabrication inspection and field testing; the term is from February 2, 2026 through February 1, 2027; the term of the original contract is from February 2, 2023 through February 1, 2026; the total amount is increased from \$833,553.31 to \$1,769,664.19; the cost will be charged to Account No. 20101 449080 8170010 (DPS Engineering Construction). (2023-30-015M1) Motion Carried.

Alan Ko provided an overview.

There was a discussion about completion estimated for this fall, and complaints about traffic backups and traffic signal timing.
