Communication dated May 13, 2025 (received June 3rd) from Scott Cabauatan, Deputy Director, Department of Public Services, forwarding the April 2025 report of all complaint calls made to 1-888-Road-Crew sorted by Commission district pursuant to Enrolled Ordinance No. 2024-664, page 16, item 6. (2025-33-015)
2. Communication dated April 29, 2025 (received May 19th) requesting Commission approval of a contract between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Transportation in the estimated amount of \$2,590,030 for road improvements along Middlebelt Road from Joy Road to Plymouth Road in the City of Livonia; the County Executive's Office advises that funding will consist of \$2,119,939 in federal STP-U funds and Wayne County will contribute \$470,091; the term of the contract will commence upon Commission approval through September 30, 2030; the revenue from the contract will be deposited into Account No. 201 44905 511250 (\$2,119,939 Federal STP-U Funds); the cost of the contract will be charged to Account Nos. 201 44908 818080 (\$2,252,200 Construction Cost) and 201 44908 702000 (\$337,830 Construction Engineering Cost). 3. Communication dated February 18, 2025 (received May 29th) requesting Commission approval of a three-year purchase order (PO) with two, one-year options to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Truck & Trailer Specialties, Inc. (of Dutton) not to exceed \$200,000 for Scorpion attenuator parts for the Department of Public Services, Equipment Division; the County Executive advises that 1 bid was received in response to 134 direct solicitations; after review, the Procurement Division recommends award to Truck & Trailer Specialties, Inc., as the apparent low bidder, which was determined to be both responsive and responsible; the term of the PO will commence upon Commission approval for three years; the cost of the PO will be charged to Account No. 201 44900 745000 (Roads-Equipment). Communication dated May 14, 2025 (received May 23rd) requesting Commission approval of the proposed sewage disposal rates for the Rouge Valley Sewage Disposal System at a monthly fixed charge of \$4,876,591 (annualized amount of \$58,519,096), which reflects a 0.48% decrease over the current monthly fixed rate; the annual debt charge is \$1,277,978; the rates are effective July 1, 2023. (2025-70-010)
5. Communication dated April 24, 2025 (received May 22nd) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 1 to a three-year contract with two, one-year options to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Concrete Cutting & Breaking Co. (of Grand Rapids), with no change in the dollar amount, exercising the first option to renew, to amend Appendix B and to continue providing concrete cutting services, on an as-needed basis; the total contract not-to-exceed amount remains \$250,000; the term of Amendment No. 1 is from April 21, 2025 through April 20, 2026; the cost of Amendment No. 1 will be charged to Account No. 201 44906 817000 (Roads-Roads Maintenance).
