The Committee moved items E.1-2 together.

1. Peterson-Mayberry/Killeen **Approved.** Amendment No. 2 to a three-year comparable-source professional services contract between the Charter County of Wayne and CTS Companies (of Bloomfield Hills) not to exceed \$129,506.32, extending the term, to continue providing project coordination, installation and leasing of telephone equipment and training at four County probation offices and to add equipment and licenses for the Southwest District probation office; the term is extended through December 16, 2028; the term of the original contract and previous amendment is from November 17, 2022 through December 16, 2026; the total amount is increased from \$180,216 to \$309,722.32; the cost will be charged to Account No. 63501 258060 8510090 (IT Telecommunications). 2. Peterson-Mayberry/Killeen

Approved. Amendment No. 3 to a two-year sole-source software license, equipment acquisition and services contract with a 26-month option to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Next Generation Software, Inc. dba SimplyWork (of Neenah, WI) in the amount of \$5,051.54 to purchase two time clocks for Clerk's Office use at the Lincoln Hall of Justice; the term remains from October 1, 2019 through November 30, 2026; the total amount is increased from \$145,716 to \$150,767.54; the cost will be charged to Account No. 10110 215010 9610000 (WCCO Family). (2020-80-001M3) Motion Carried.

Dwayne Seals provided an overview.

The department indicated that the time clocks that are used are more modernized and can be used by badge, fingerprint or retinal recognition. There was further discussion regarding whether this sole-source contract will be bid out or continued.
