1. Killeen/Marecki **Forwarded to Full Board to receive and file.** Communication from Charli E. Rose, Division Director, Medical Examiner's Office, Health, Human & Veterans Services Department, forwarding the Medical Examiner's Turnaround Time Analysis report for April 2026 to June 2026, pursuant to Enrolled Ordinance No. 2025-659, page 18, item 9. (2026-09-007) Motion Carried.

Charli E. Rose provided an overview.

Ms. Rose indicated that during 91-day period 3,818 decedents were reported to the Medical Examiner's Office, which took jurisdiction of 657 cases. 479 received full autopsies, 143 received inspection only and 33 of the cases were limited autopsy. Of the 355 cases submitted for histology, the turnaround time was 3.2 days. For the final cause of death of 657 cases, 316 cases had an average turnaround time of

16.7 days. The remaining 130 cases had an average turnaround time of 40.7 days. During 91-day period, there were 2,754 requests for cremation and had a same day turnaround time.

2. Anderson/Marecki

Approved. A 36-month software acquisition contract with up to two, one-year options to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and HS Gov Tech USA, Inc. (of Charlotte, NC) not to exceed \$272,600 to provide the HSCloud Suite, a secure, cloud-based software-as-a-service platform to support the Department of Health, Human and Veterans Services, Public Health Division, Environmental Health program operations; the Executive's Office advises that the HSCloud Suite will support Public Health staff, inspectors, managers, and leadership in performing permitting and licensing, inspection and case management, reporting and analytics, and an operator/public portal for regulated entities; the term will commence upon Commission approval for 36 months; the cost will be charged to Account Nos. 22101 601970 7270110 (\$166,000 Strengthening PH Workforce Infr) and 22101 372010 7270110 (\$106,600 HHVS Food Inspection). Dr. Briana Eccleston provided an overview.

There was a discussion regarding being the first in the state of Michigan to use the program and the program allowing for inspections for more restaurants and tracking more complaints.
