Communication dated August 12, 2025 (received October 27th) requesting Commission approval of an intergovernmental agreement with a one-year option to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Michigan State University (MSU) (of East Lansing) not to exceed \$7,515,000 to launch the RxKids Program, designed to improve maternal-infant health, early childhood development and community wellbeing; MSU will subcontract 99.7%/\$7,490,750 to GiveDirectly, Inc. (of New York, NY) to oversee all aspects of direct cash payment administration, including participant intake and verification, payment distribution and follow-up, customer support, ongoing safe guarding and audit measures to ensure program integrity and prevent fraud; the term of the agreement will commence upon Commission approval through December 31, 2028; the cost of the agreement will be charged to Account No. 499 24499 817000 (Well Wayne Project-Public Heal).
