Communication dated July 23, 2024 (received August 5th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 9 to a five-year professional services contract with a one-year option to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Assured Family Services (of Detroit) not to exceed \$2,000,000, to add funding for the CHOICES and Target Case Management programs, for the continued provision of juvenile and youth assessment, mental health and substance abuse testing services; Assured Family Services will subcontract with Alpha Family Counseling (of Canton) for treatment, Family Care Network (of Detroit) for treatment, Franklin Wright Settlements (of Detroit) for treatment, Support Management Services (of Livonia) for treatment, Joyce Alexander (of Southfield) for treatment, Key Insights, LLC (of Detroit) for treatment, Sandra Tambor (of Brownstown) for treatment, Professional Outreach Counseling (of Taylor) for treatment, DML Psychological Services, PLLC (of Novi) for psychological testing, First Family Counseling (of Detroit) for treatment, Positive Images, Inc. (of Detroit) for treatment and Evolution Counseling & Consulting, LLC (of Detroit) for treatment; Amendment No. 9 increases the total contract not-to-exceed amount from \$96,337,916.75 to \$98,337,916.75; the term of the contract remains from July 1, 2018 through March 31, 2025; the cost of Amendment No. 9 will be charged to Account Nos. 292 35612 817000 (\$1,800,000 Program Development - Juvenile) and 292 35612 817400 (\$200,000 Program Development - Juvenile).
