for juvenile offenders in Wayne County; the County Executive advises that funding for services provided to youths ages 7-17 will be supported with 50% from general fund dollars and 50% from the State of Michigan's Child Care Fund, per the Amendment No. 4 not-to-exceed amount, Spectrum Juvenile Justice Services will subcontract 2.67%/\$492,992 to Kyle Smith, DO (of Beverly Hills) for child psychiatric care, assessment and consultation, 1.59%/\$292,784.63 to Dr. Curtis Longs (of Southfield) for child psychiatric care, assessment and consultation, 0.26%/\$47,250 to Marvin Wheeler (of Redford Township) for barber services, 0.87%/\$161,516.25 to Wayne Veal, DDS (of Detroit) for dental services, 1.07%/\$196,875 to Angela Eburuche (of Bingham Farms) for nursing practitioner services and 0.30%/\$55,282.50 to Rochelle Belton-Ford (of Detroit) for dental hygienist services; Amendment No. 4 increases the total contract not-to-exceed amount from \$35,936,133.40 to \$54,397,468.40; the term of Amendment No. 4 is from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026; the cost of Amendment No. 4 will be charged to Account No. 292 35612 817000 (Program Development-Juvenile).
