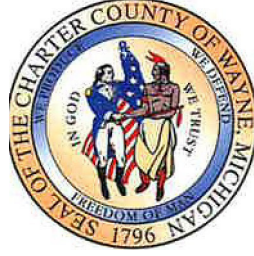

Communication dated February 2, 2026 (received March 3rd) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 3 to the Prosecuting Cold Cases Using DNA Grant award between the Charter County of Wayne and the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, with no change in the dollar amount, extending the term; the Prosecutor's Office advises that the grant assists its Homicide Unit and the Detroit Police Department's Inactive Squad using DNA technology to investigate homicide cases from 2015 through 2017; the term is extended through September 30, 2026; the term of the original agreement and previous amendments was from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2025; the total amount remains \$470,000, with no County match; the revenue will continue to be deposited into Account No. 101110 296060 5290000 (WCPO Cold Case DNA Testing). 2. Communication dated February 17, 2026 (received March 3rd) requesting Commission approval of a one-year grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of State Police, Emergency Management and Homeland Security Division, in the amount of \$18,900, with no County match, for the Fiscal Year 2025 Emergency Management Performance Grant to award federal pass-through funds to the County for the development and maintenance of the County's Emergency Management Program; the term is from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025; the revenue will be deposited into Account No. 101110 426070 5290000 (HMLS Emerg Prepared Perform Grant).
