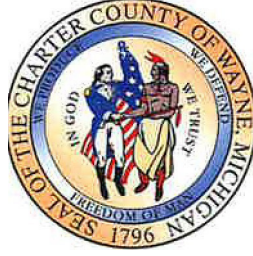

Communication dated May 29, 2026 (received June 10th) requesting Commission approval of a one-year grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of State Police, Emergency Management and Homeland Security Division, not to exceed \$21,313, which includes a 25 percent County match of \$4,263, for the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Planning Program to provide federal pass-through funds for the development of new Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act, Title III, Section 302, hazardous materials emergency response plans for first responders; the term is from October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; the revenue will be deposited into Account No. 10110 426050 5290000 (HMLS Hazardous Materials Emergency). 2. Communication dated June 10, 2026 (received June 23rd) requesting Commission approval of retroactive Amendment No. 1 to a two-year subaward agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and Avalon Healing Center (of Detroit) (formerly Wayne County Sexual Assault Forensic Nurse Examiners (WC SAFE)), not to exceed \$10,000, extending the term to continue to provide victim advocacy work in partnership with the Wayne County Sexual Assault Kit Task Force; the total amount is increased from \$236,415 to \$246,415; the term is extended through September 30, 2026; the term of the original agreement was from October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2025; the cost will be charged to Account No. 10101 228040 8170010 (SAKI 2022). Communication dated May 22, 2026 (received July 2nd) requesting Commission approval of a three-year professional services contract with one, two-year option to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and U.S. Corrections, LLC (of Whites Creek, TN) not to exceed \$300,000 for extradition services for defendants who have left the area to avoid prosecution or are incarcerated elsewhere and witnesses incarcerated elsewhere who are required to testify; the Procurement Division advises that three proposals were received in response to 818 direct solicitations and a 35-day posting on BidNetDirect.com (Request For Proposals No. 37-25-083); after review, the Procurement Division recommends U.S. Corrections, LLC, which received the highest evaluation score; the term is from August 1, 2026 through July 31, 2029; the cost will be charged to Account No. 10110 296010 8610010 (WCPO Prosecuting Attorney).
