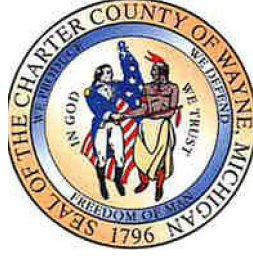

Communication dated February 26, 2026 (received April 27th) requesting Commission approval of a one-year grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Corrections, Office of Community Corrections, in the amount of \$900,000, with no County match, for comprehensive plans and services for Fiscal Year 2026, to support approximately 3,000 sentenced County offenders, including jail-based cognitive behavioral therapy, community- and jail-based domestic violence prevention treatment, women's trauma-informed care programming, and violence and intervention services; the term is from October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; the revenue will be deposited into Account No. 28101 354010 5430010 (HHVS Community Corrections). Note: On April 29, 2026, Chair Bell authorized exigent approval of the contract in the amount of \$900,000 under the provisions of the Procurement Ordinance and has advised that this is for a period not to exceed 60 days at which time the appropriate Committee(s) of the Commission will complete the review of this matter.

6. Communication dated March 23, 2026 (received April 17th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 1 to a one-year grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services not to exceed \$97,971, with no County match, for the Fiscal Year 2026 Crime Victim Supplemental Funding program for the Prosecutor's Office; the term remains from October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; the total amount is increased from \$197,616 to \$295,587; the revenue will be deposited into Account No. 10110 228110 5690010 (Crime Victim Supplemental Fund). Communication dated March 27, 2026 (received May 5th) requesting Commission approval of a retroactive subrecipient agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and Michigan Organizing Project dba Michigan United (of Detroit) not to exceed \$389,821, through the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Byrne State Crisis Intervention Program grant agreement from the State of Michigan, to recruit, train and employ trusted community members to educate about Michigan's new gun safety laws; it will subcontract 12.9%/\$50,350 to Social Program Evaluators and Consultants, Inc. dba SPEC Associates (of Southfield) for program evaluation services; the term is from June 1, 2024 through December 30, 2026; the cost will be charged to Account No. 10110 354045 8170010 (Byrne State Crisis Intrvn).
