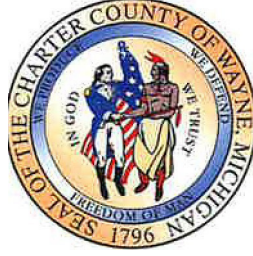

E. New Business

1. Communication dated July 11, 2024 (received September 12th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 1 to a two-year contract with one, two-year option to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Lakeridge Village, Inc. (of Detroit) not to exceed \$140,000, exercising the option to renew, to continue to provide community-based, residential rehabilitation treatment and services for adult offenders who remain in the criminal justice system and are homeless or diagnosed with mental health or substance use disorders; the Sheriff advises that services include housing, medical services, substance abuse treatment, mental health referrals and/or services and life skills education to ensure successful re-entry into the community; Amendment No. 1 increases the total contract not-to-exceed amount from \$170,000 to \$310,000; the term of Amendment No. 1 is from April 2, 2024 through April 1, 2026; the cost of Amendment No. 1 will be charged to Account No. 101 35104 815002 (Residential Outplacement). 2. Communication dated October 9, 2024 (received October 16th) requesting Commission approval of a grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services in the amount of \$1,324,916, with no County match required, for the Fiscal Year 2025 Crime Victim Rights grant award, which will cover the personnel costs of 11 victim advocates, one social worker, one project manager and two department supervisors for the Prosecutor's Office; the term of the agreement is from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025; the revenue from the grant will be deposited into Account No. 282 22904 569000 (Victim Wtnss(P.Atty)). 3. Communication dated October 9, 2024 (received October 16th) requesting Commission approval of a grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services in the amount of \$168,491, with no County match required, for the Fiscal Year 2025 Sexual Assault Victim Rights grant award, which will fund two sexual assault victim advocates for the Wayne County Sexual Assault Kit Task Force; the term of the agreement is from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025; the revenue from the grant will be deposited into Account No. 101 22921 569000 (CVSC -Rape Kit Grant). 4. Communication dated October 10, 2024 (received October 17th) requesting Commission approval of the Fiscal Year 2025 Auto Theft Prevention Authority grant contract between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of State Police in the amount of \$1,502,814, which will supplement the salary and benefits of 7 assistant prosecutors, 2 part-time project consultant attorneys, 1 clerical specialist and 1 victim advocate for the Prosecutor's Office; the Prosecutor advises that 60%/\$901,688.40 will come from the State with a County match of 40%/\$601,125.60; the term of the contract is from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025; the revenue from the contract will be deposited into Account No. 101 22911 569000 (Pros Auto Theft Unit - PATU).
