Communication dated August 22, 2024 (received September 4th) requesting Commission approval of a grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services in the amount of \$731,384, with no County match required, for the Fiscal Year 2025 Culturally Specific Responsive Services for Underserved Victims of Crime grant, which will cover the personnel costs of 9 social service specialists, 1 social worker and 1 clerical specialist and expand and enhance crime victim services; the term of the agreement is from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025; the revenue from the agreement will be deposited into Account No. 282 22965 529000 (Spec ADVOC-VOCA). Communication dated August 22, 2024 (received August 28th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 1 to a one-year grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Corrections, Office of Community Corrections, to decrease funding in the amount of \$200,000 to account for the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 payment adjustment for the Community Corrections Plan and Programs; the County Executive advises that the funding decrease is a result of delayed program implementation and subsequent lower utilization; Amendment No. 1 decreases the total agreement not-to-exceed amount from \$1,987,876 to \$1,787,876; the term of the agreement remains from October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024; the revenue from the agreement will continue to be deposited into Account No. 281 32000 543000 (Community Correction).  4. Communication dated June 24, 2024 (received July 16th) requesting Commission approval of a five-year Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Charter County of Wayne and the Wayne County Sheriff's Office not to exceed \$1,693,870 for the implementation of the following three Wayne County Community Corrections programs, which are designed to improve public safety and further the goals of Public Act 511: GPS Tether and Monitoring Services, Fugitive Apprehension Services and Drunk Driver Jail Reduction (DDJR)/Community Treatment Program (5-day Residential in Jail); the term of the MOU is from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2029; the cost of the MOU will be charged to Account No. 281 32000 817000 (Community Corrections).
