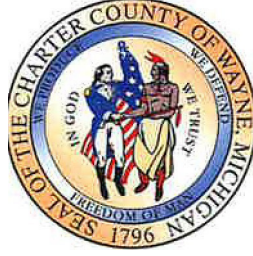

E. New Business

1. Communication dated September 24, 2025 (received September 30th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 1 to a 26-month High Crime Community Support grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Treasury, Revenue Sharing and Grants Division, extending the term of the agreement by 12 months, for the Prosecutor's Office to address case backlogs through retention, recruitment, equipment and training; the total agreement amount remains in the amount of \$5,000,000, with no County match required; Amendment No. 1 extends the term of the agreement from August 1, 2023 through September 30, 2026; the revenue from the agreement will continue to be deposited into Account No. 101 22812 569000 (High Crime Community Support). Note: On September 30, 2025, Chair Bell authorized exigent approval of the amendment under the provisions of the Procurement Ordinance and has advised that this is for a period not to exceed 60 days at which time the appropriate Committee(s) of the Commission will complete the review of this matter.

2. Communication dated August 26, 2025 (received September 19th) requesting Commission approval of retroactive Amendment No. 1 to a two-year comparable-source master services and purchasing agreement, additional and supplemental terms and conditions to the master services and purchasing agreement and Axon Evidence Justice Services agreement with four, two-year options to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Axon Enterprise, Inc. (of Scottsdale, AZ) not to exceed \$850,080, exercising the first option to renew, for a digital evidence management system with unlimited cloud storage for the Prosecutor's Office; Amendment No. 1 increases the total agreement not-to-exceed amount from \$820,330 to \$1,670,410; the term of Amendment No. 1 is from September 19, 2025 through September 18, 2027; the cost of Amendment No. 1 will be charged to Account No. 101 22900 981000 (Prosecuting Attorney). 3. Communication dated September 15, 2025 (received October 9th) requesting Commission approval of retroactive Amendment No. 2 to a comparable-source subrecipient agreement with two, one-year options to renew with Black Family Development, Inc. (of Detroit), with no change in the dollar amount, exercising the final option to renew, to assign a name change to Centers for Family Development, Inc. dba Black Family Development and to continue the administration of a women-specific, trauma-informed relapse prevention program; the total agreement not-to-exceed amount remains \$225,000; the term of Amendment No. 2 is from October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; the cost of the agreement will continue to be charged to Account No. 281 32000 817000 (Community Correction).
