Communication dated May 20, 2025 (received June 11th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 1 to a Co-location License Agreement, Memorandum of Agreement and Integration Agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the State of Michigan, Department of Technology, Management, and Budget, Office of the Michigan Public Safety Communications System (MPSCS), to amend and add to various sections of the Integration Agreement; the Executive's Office advises that the Integration Agreement provides public safety responders such as fire, emergency medical services, law enforcement and public service departments access to the premier interoperable communications technology available and allows the Wayne County Simulcast System to participate in the State of Michigan MPSCS system; the term of the Co-location License Agreement and Memorandum of Agreement are 10 years with various effective dates; the term of the Integration Agreement is from June 24, 2016 through June 23, 2026 and will automatically renew for successive 10-year periods unless either party provides the other party with written notice of termination.
