

North Branch of Ecorse Creek Drain Tree Removal and Restoration



Why are trees being removed?

- To create access to the drain.
- To remove log jams and debris to improve drain flow.
- To reduce future obstructions in the drain.

What happens during tree removal?

- Trees will be cut approximately 12 feet from the drain's top of bank and within drain banks.
- Trees will be hauled away and stumps will be sprayed to minimize regrowth.



What is the restoration process?

- After the tree removal process, restoration begins.
- Restoration consists of seeding to promote regrowth of grass.

When will the site be restored?

- Weather dependent, full restoration will be completed in approximately 6 to 8 months.
