Fordson Substitute Teacher Charged With Drug Crimes

Today Jehad Hassan Dakroub, 26 of Dearborn was charged by Prosecutor Kym L. Worthy with Possession with Intent to Deliver Marijuana 5 to 45 kilograms that carries a maximum penalty of 7 years in prison and Possession with Intent to Deliver Ecstasy that carries a maximum penalty of 20 years in prison

On May 23, 2006, a search warrant was executed at Mr. Dakroub's home on Curtis Street in Dearborn. Approximately 18 pounds of marijuana and 153 Ecstasy pills were confiscated. Mr. Dakroub was reportedly employed by the Dearborn Public School system as an "in house" substitute teacher and a coach of the junior varsity tennis team.

Prosecutor Worthy said, "This man was entrusted with molding the minds of children each day. It's especially abhorrent to find that a teacher would be charged with having a virtual drug factory in his home. We warn our children about the dangers of drugs all the time. This is exactly what we tell our children to guard against."
