Daryl M. Carson graduated from Wayne State University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration. After receiving her Juris Doctorate from Indiana University, she began her career as a criminal defense attorney with the Legal Aid and Defender Association of Michigan. She subsequently opened a private practice with a fellow Defender, specializing in criminal defense and family law.

In 2001, Ms. Carson became an Assistant Wayne County Prosecuting Attorney in the General Trial Unit, managing a daily courtroom docket. She was then assigned to handle the Federal Gun Program in conjunction with the U.S. Attorney's Office. Ms. Carson received two promotions while in the General Trial Unit beginning in 2004 when she became a supervisor managing and mentoring six Assistant Prosecuting Attorneys; then Deputy Chief in August 2010, overseeing the daily operations of the Unit; and supervising four principal and lead attorneys, 23 Assistant Prosecuting Attorneys and support staff. On October 1, 2018, she was appointed Chief of Staff of the Wayne County Prosecutor's Office.

Ms. Carson has served on the Board of Directors for Pierre Toussaint Academy, a charter school, both as a member and its President for over 10 years. She worked closely with the board members as well as the Authorizer, Ferris State University; School Leader; Educational Service Provider and other Charter School Boards.
