HUMAN TRAFFICKING CASES

What is Human Trafficking?

Human Trafficking is a crime that involves exploiting a person for labor, services, or commercial sex. (Federal Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000* and its subsequent reauthorizations)

- 1. Sex trafficking is a commercial sex act is induced by force, fraud, or coercion, or without force, fraud or coercion if the person being trafficked is under 18 years or age
- <u>2. Labor Trafficking</u> is the recruitment, harboring, transportation, provision, or obtaining of a person for labor or services, using force, fraud, or coercion

People often falsely believe "human trafficking" implies victims must be moved from one place to another to qualify as a victim. Human trafficking <u>does not require transportation</u> to be considered a crime

HOW MUCH TIME


- Months of investigation:
 - The police agencies spend weeks and/or months investigating human trafficking suspects
 - We are involved with these investigations because the agencies send various search warrants for our review
 - Ex: Suspect RC—About 3 months of search warrants during their investigation before a warrant request was ever sent to us (First SW 3/22/2021, warrant submission 6/16/2021)






FURTHER INVESTIGATION AFTER A WARRANT HAS BEEN SUBMITTED FOR OUR REVIEW

- Additional evidence: Police reports, SANE reports, photos, body worn camera, DNA, Lab, 911 calls
- · Statements from additional witnesses
- · Receipts/records from hotels
- Surveillance Videos from hotels
- · Specifics of force, fraud, coercion, drug use
- · Records of electronic monetary transactions
- Extractions of electronic devices used to post/to set up dates. Thousands of Pages

Pre-Charge Time:

- Hours of review prior to charging
- Reports, written statements, body camera videos, recorded interviews, surveillance videos, maps, photos, medical records, lab reports for DNA, narcotics, and firearms
 - o Ex: One case took over a week of review prior to charging
- Time in court:
 - Motions
 - Multiple days/hearings to complete
 - Adjournments review evidence
 - Transient victims
 - Defendants who know the system
 - Lengthy trials—10+ days of trial, several witnesses, plethora of exhibits



PEOPLE V. DOUGLAS GARDNER

- May 8, 2021, warrant request, for a missing juvenile, A.P., who was recovered from a motel
- Investigation revealed A.P. was being trafficked by the man she was with when she was recovered, Douglas Gardner.
- Charges: HT, Statutory rape, dissemination of child sexually abusive material
 - A.P. taken to the west side of Michigan because she had previously taken her foster mom's car and run away to Detroit. After she testified at the PEX, A.P. returned to a juvenile facility in mid-Michigan. She seemed to be doing well but Shortly after going to her foster placement, A.P. again stole her foster parents' car, cut off her tether, and returned to Detroit.
 - This case recently resolved Guilty Plea. But...

PEOPLE V. A.P.S.- TIMELINE

- A local human trafficking news article came to our attention months after AP ran away.
- We suspected this incident might involve A.P. (People v. Douglas Gardner)
- A.P. was recovered on November 16, 2021 by the Michigan State Police. This time, her trafficker, A.P.S., was more violent. He was not only trafficking A.P., he was trafficking at least 3 adult victims as well.
- We learned our victim was driving a vehicle at 2:15 am (she's 15) and her vehicle was stopped. She was picked up as a suspected missing person she disclosed she had been trafficked by 3 individuals at Woodward Inn Hotel. AP would only name 1 trafficker.
- Our office was presented with seven phone extractions, hundreds of photos, nearly 50 videos, and recorded interviews of the victims. After over a week of reviewing the evidence, A.P.S. was charged with eight trafficking offenses, three sexual assault offenses, and five prostitution related offenses. He remains in custody with his case pending.

(WXYZ) — Michigan State Police say they have opened a sex trafficking investigation after they pulled over a 15-year-old girl near 8 Mile and Schoenherr on the Warren, Detroit border early Tuesday morning.

Police say the driver did not have ID and provided a false name. According to police, after an initial investigation, they discovered that the teen was a missing/runaway out of Jackson County, who was reported missing in September.

The teen then told officers that she believed she might be pregnant and was a victim of sex trafficking, police say.

WHAT WE LEARNED FROM THESE CASES

- Victims are often trafficked repeatedly
- In this case A.P.'s traffickers became more violent
- Keeping victims safe is a challenge because they are accustomed to running (A.P. left her foster care parent's home stole their car and went back on the streets)
- Victims can present as much older than their actual age
- Significant time, effort and money is necessary to rehabilitate victims of trafficking
- Trained officers, prosecutors and advocates in human trafficking are essential

CURRENT CASE LOAD

- · 2 APAS Grace & Danielle
- 17 Active cases
- · 14 Cases pending review
- Victims may have their own cases
- Several other violent cases extortion, involving guns, torture, etc.

RESOURCES WE NEED

- We dream of expanding our team
- Create a Multiple Disciplinary Team (MDT)
 - HT Victim advocates that can help with addiction, housing, personal protective orders, legitimate employment, and mental health treatment.
 - HT investigator to help locate transient victims
 - Access to Child Advocacy Centers, KidsTalk
 - Partnership with community organizations to educate about trafficking, assist with victim needs - medical care, housing, psychological support and empowerment
