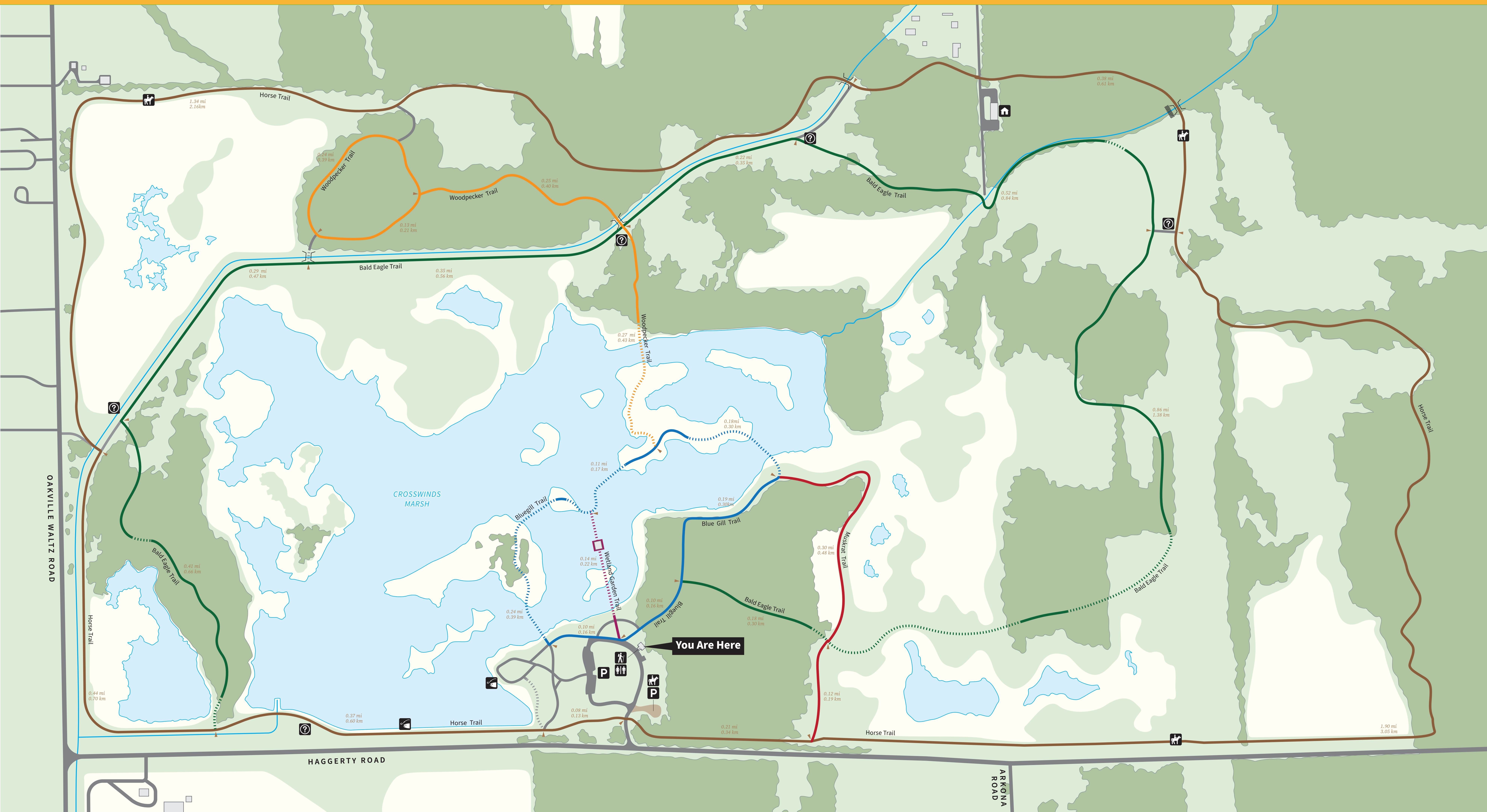


Crosswinds Marsh

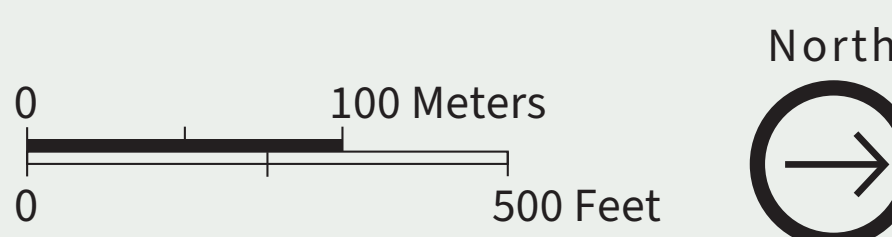

PARK HOURS

PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

PERMITS

Pavilion is reserved by permit, otherwise is available on a first come-first serve basis. Relocation of park tables from one location to another and the posting of signs of any type is prohibited.

PARKING

Stopping, standing, or parking allowed in designated areas only. Vehicles may not be left overnight.

VEHICLES

Operation limited to designated drive or roadways only. Motor driven All-Terrain vehicles, trail or mini bikes, scooters, or snowmobiles are prohibited. Vehicle maintenance, storage, or abandonment is prohibited.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Written permit required for the special events of any kind. Any business solicitation, advertisement, distribution of handbills of any kind, and selling of property or privilege is prohibited.

UNLAWFUL OBSTRUCTION

To interfere or obstruct any other person from entering, leaving or making full use of the park is prohibited.

PRESERVATION OF PLANT LIFE

No person shall cut, remove, or destroy any tree, sapling, brush, shrub, flower, or grass, whether dead or alive, or deface or injure plant life.

PRESERVATION OF PROPERTY

Persons who destroy, alter, remove, deface, or damage any park property shall be prosecuted. This includes facilities, site furnishings, signage, plants, and grounds.

FISHING AND HUNTING

Fishing permitted in designated areas in accordance with state law. Persons who hunt, trap, catch, wound, or kill park wildlife, or disturb nests or resting places of park wildlife shall be prosecuted.

ANIMALS

Dogs or other animals must be controlled on a leash. Feeding wild animals is not permitted. Release of any animal upon park property is prohibited.

HORSEBACK RIDING

Horseback riding permitted in posted areas only. Pedestrians yield to horses.

BOATING

Personal watercraft is not permitted.

FIREWORKS AND FIRES

Fireworks and fires of any kind are prohibited.

WATER RECREATION

No ice fishing, ice skating or swimming permitted. Keep off ice. Stay out of water. Keep off spillway dam.

ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

Consumption or possession of alcohol or intoxicating or illegal substances, with the exception of beer, is prohibited.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

To engage in any violent, abusive, loud, vulgar, lewd, obscene, or otherwise disorderly conduct tending to create a breach of the peace, or disturb or annoy others within the Wayne County Park System is prohibited and subject to fines and removal from the Park.

FINES AND IMPRISONMENT

Persons violating Park Rules and Regulations shall be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

LOITERING, LITTERING, POLLUTING AND CRUISING ARE PROHIBITED
