The Wayne County Drain Commissioner will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the McKinstry Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced.

The McKinstry Drain project will be let in 3 sections as follows, each section having the length, average depth and width as set forth: Section 1 – Open Channel approximately 6,800 feet in length. Said open channel to have 8- to 20-foot wide bottom width, with maximum 2 horizontal to 1 vertical side slopes and an average depth of 7 feet. Section 2 – Open Channel approximately 5,500 ft in length. Said open channel to have 4-foot wide bottom width, with maximum 1.5 horizontal to 1 vertical side slopes and an average depth of 4 feet. Section 3 – Open Channel approximately 7,000 ft in length. Said open channel to have 2-foot wide bottom width, with maximum 1.5 horizontal to 1 vertical side slopes and an average depth of 4 feet.

All stations are 100 feet apart. The following items will be required and a contract let for the same:

A bid security deposit in the form of a cashier’s check, money order, certified check or bidders bond shall be submitted with any bids. No cash will be permitted. Bid security of other bidders will be returned within 15 days of the bid award recommendation. The bid security shall be made payable to the County of Wayne and reference “McKinstry Drain Project,” in amount of five (5) percent of the Bidder’s maximum bid price.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

The following is a condensed description of the several tracts or parcels of lands constituting the McKinstry Drain Drainage District. The description of area that is served by the McKinstry Drain consists of lands situated in sections 26 & 33 – 35 of Canton Township, T.2S.-R.8E., in Wayne County, Michigan and sections 2 – 4 & 9 – 10 of Van Buren Township, T.3S.-R.8E., in Wayne County, Michigan.

Canton Township – T.2S.-R.8E.

In Section 26 – The Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section.

In Section 33 – The Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section, the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section, and the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section.

In Section 34 – The South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the section, the portion of the Northeast section South of Michigan Ave., and the portion of the Northwest section South of Michigan Ave.

In Section 35 – The West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the section.

Van Buren Township – T.3S.-R.8E.

In Section 2 – The Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section and the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section.

In Section 3 – The North $\frac{1}{2}$ of the section, the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section, the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section, the North $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section, and the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section.
