5. Communication dated December 18, 2025 (received January 8th) requesting Commission approval of a grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR) in the amount of \$245,260 for the 2025 Marine Safety Program; the Sheriff's Office advises that the grant agreement is funded by two sources through the DNR -- one allocation is from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Coast Guard, in the amount of \$116,060, with no County match, and the other allocation is from the DNR in the amount of \$104,200, with a County match of \$25,000; the term of the federal funding is from January 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025 and the term of the state funding is from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025; the revenue will be deposited into Account Nos. 10110 350070 5290000 (\$116,060 WCSO Marine Law Enforcement) and 10110 350070 5430010 (\$104,200 WCSO Marine Law Enforcement). 6. Communication dated January 12, 2026 (received January 21st) requesting Commission approval of retroactive Amendment No. 1 to a two-year intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with two, one-year options to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and the Wayne County Airport Authority (Authority) not to exceed \$75,000, exercising the first option to renew, for the Sheriff's Office to use the Authority's Firearms Range Building at Detroit Metropolitan Airport in Romulus for gun training; the Sheriff's Office advises that the County will provide all ammunition, targets, target backing, staple guns and staples necessary for the use of the range; the total amount is increased from \$100,000 to \$175,000; the term is from August 17, 2025 through August 16, 2026; the term of the original IGA was from August 17, 2023 through August 16, 2025; the cost will be charged to Account No. 101 35100 961000 (County Jail).
