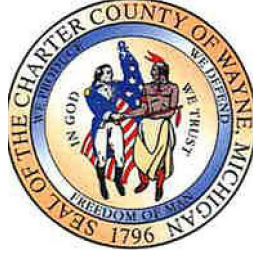

E. New Business

1. Communication dated September 3, 2025 (received October 13th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 2 to a one-year intergovernmental agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the State of Michigan not to exceed \$231,665.68, through the State of Michigan Department of Technology, Management, and Budget (MiDEAL) contract No. 171 180000000749, to pay outstanding invoices for the completion of digital imaging for the Prosecutor's Office; Amendment No. 2 increases the total agreement not-to-exceed amount from \$1,493,528.46 to \$1,725,194.14; the term of the agreement remains from February 16, 2023 through September 30, 2025; the cost of Amendment No. 2 will be charged to Account No. 101 22900 961000 (Prosecuting Attorney). 2. Communication dated October 20, 2025 (received November 6th) requesting Commission approval of a one-year grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services not to exceed \$197,616, with no County match required, for the Fiscal Year 2026 Crime Victim Supplemental Funding program to fund one social worker and one victim advocate for the Prosecutor's Office; the term of the agreement is from October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; the revenue from the agreement will be deposited into Account No. 101 22811 569000 (Prosecuting Attorney). 3. Communication dated September 4, 2025 (received November 19th) requesting Commission approval of an intergovernmental agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and Schoolcraft College not to exceed \$143,116 to provide police recruit academy training, through the Wayne County Regional Police Training Academy, for up to 19 Wayne County Sheriff Office recruits over two sessions, as required by the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards; the term of the agreement is from July 18, 2025 through September 30, 2026; the cost of the agreement will be charged to Account No. 101 35120 961000 (Sheriff-Training Academy).
