Communication dated July 7, 2025 (received July 10th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 1 to the Fiscal Year 2022 Sexual Assault Kit Initiative grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, with no change in the dollar amount, extending the term of the agreement by one year, to continue funding the cost of seven full-time Wayne County Sexual Assault Kit Task Force detectives; the total agreement amount remains \$1,500,000, with no County match required; Amendment No. 1 extends the term of the agreement from October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2026; the revenue from the agreement will continue to be deposited into Account No. 101 22804 529000 (SAKI-2022). 6. Communication dated July 7, 2025 (received July 10th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 1 to a two-year grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, with no change in the dollar amount, extending the term of the agreement by one year, for the Fiscal Year 2023 Upholding the Rule of Law and Preventing Wrongful Convictions Program Grant Award that funds two Assistant Prosecuting Attorneys, maintenance/upgrade of the Conviction Integrity Unit's database and the costs of conducting a sentinel review in the Prosecutor's Office; the total agreement amount remains \$599,988, with no County match required; Amendment No. 1 extends the term of the agreement from October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2026; the

revenue from the agreement will continue to be deposited into Account No. 101 22807 529000 (Prosecuting Attorney). (2024-93-001M1)

7. Communication dated July 8, 2025 (received July 14th) requesting Commission approval of a grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of State Police, Emergency Management & Homeland Security Division, in the amount of \$146,250, with no County match required, for the Fiscal Year 2024 Homeland Security Grant Program-Operation Stonegarden grant; the Executive's Office advises that the County receives federal pass-through funds to enhance cooperation and coordination among local, tribal, state and federal agencies in a joint mission to secure the United States and Canadian borders; the term of the agreement is from September 1, 2024 through July 31, 2027; the revenue from the agreement will be deposited into Account No. 101 42606 529000 (Stone Garden Grant). Communication dated May 1, 2025 (received May 14th) requesting Commission approval of a five-month memorandum of understanding (MOU) between the Wayne County Sheriff's Department and the Michigan Department of the Attorney General not to exceed \$106,250 to provide executive protection detail services for Attorney General Dana Nessel at her residence; the Sheriff's Office advises that it will not be compensated for mileage, travel time, waiting time or other time spent actively performing services under this MOU; the term of the MOU is from October 1, 2024 through February 28, 2025; the revenue from the MOU will be deposited into Account No. 101 30760 676020 (Road Patrol-Municipal).
