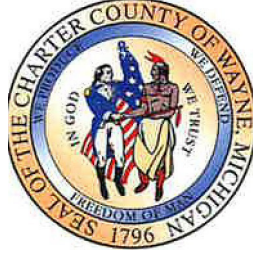

D. Unfinished Business

1. Communication dated September 4, 2025 (received November 19th) requesting Commission approval of an intergovernmental agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and Schoolcraft College not to exceed \$143,116 to provide police recruit academy training, through the Wayne County Regional Police Training Academy, for up to 19 Wayne County Sheriff Office recruits over two sessions, as required by the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards; the term of the agreement is from July 18, 2025 through September 30, 2026; the cost of the agreement will be charged to Account No. 101 35120 961000 (Sheriff-Training Academy). Communication dated October 7, 2025 (received November 21st) requesting Commission approval of an addendum to a four-year cooperative agreement with two, two-year options to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Axon Enterprise, Inc. (of Scottsdale, AZ) in the amount of \$2,350,296.61, through Sourcwell contract No. 092722-AXN, to purchase 400 conducted energy weapons, also known as Tasers, for the Sheriff's Office; the term of the addendum will commence upon Commission approval for four years; the cost of the addendum will be charged to Account No. 40101 902130 9710050 (Sheriff – Jail Capital Proj). 2. Communication dated October 20, 2025 (received December 2nd) requesting Commission approval of a twelve-month grant agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services not to exceed \$397,087, including the state providing \$297,815 and a 25% County match of \$99,272, for the Fiscal Year 2026 STOP Violence Grant for Prosecution Offices program to cover the cost of three full-time assistant prosecuting attorneys dedicated to the prosecution of domestic violence cases and related personal protection order violations; the Prosecutor's Office advises that the program is designed to expand and enhance its Domestic Violence Unit; the term of the agreement is from October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; the revenue from the agreement will be deposited into Account No. 101 22994 529000 (STOP Violence Against Women). 3. Communication dated December 2, 2025 (received December 2nd) requesting Commission approval of the reappointment of Janella Jamison Robinson to serve as a member of the Community Corrections Advisory Board, pursuant to the Community Corrections Act of 1988 (Public Act 511 of 1988; MCL 791.407(1)(l)); the term of the reappointment is from October 19, 2025 through October 18, 2029. Communication dated December 2, 2025 (received December 2nd) requesting Commission approval of the appointments of Dr. Keisha Allen and Eli Day to serve as members of the Community Corrections Advisory Board, pursuant to the Community Corrections Act of 1988 (Public Act 511 of 1988; MCL 791.407(1)); the term of the appointments is from December 18, 2025 through December 17, 2029.
